



Event Day

This sample layout is designed to demonstrate what to expect for the set-up and flow of an event. Our PackHope team will provide you with a tailored plan for your event.

EVENT SET UP

- 1 Set up each table with a designated station for each item in your kit.
- 2 Stack the boxes or pallet of each item together so you can replenish the product easily as you pack the kits.
- 3 Assign team members to specific stations.



KIT BUILDING

- 1 Bag station opens the bag for the first item. Pass down to the next station.
- 2 Each station adds their item (or items) and passes the bag down the line.
- 3 Quality Control checks to ensure each bag contains all of the items in the kit menu. Pass down to the Box Packing Station.
- 4 Box Packing Station puts the bags in the boxes, adheres the label to the outside of the box, and tapes it closed.
- 5 Pallet Packing station loads each box on the pallet. Once a pallet is full, shrink wrap, move and bring in an empty pallet.
